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## CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

### 20 Business Essentials (1, 2, or 3 Quarters)

Designed for students who have completed high school. One year of university study preferred.

The Business Essentials program offers a broad introduction to American business practices. Key business topics include Business Communication, Marketing, and Finance.

- Apply for Optional Practical Training (OPT), which allows students to work in the U.S. for up to one year, after three consecutive quarters of study.

### 21 Business Analytics (1 Quarter)

Designed for students who have a university degree or two years of full-time professional experience with a high level of English proficiency.

The expanding field of business analytics is fundamental to all facets of business across all industries, including marketing, finance, and research. Acquire a comprehensive introduction to the Business Intelligence field, and explore advanced topics such as Big Data and Predictive Analytics.

Develop your leadership skills and build your ability to influence others in the workplace. This program gives you the opportunity to join a learning community of professionals. Courses are led by practicing industry professionals.

- Learn to communicate effectively with fellow team members, direct reports, and stakeholders, who may have different backgrounds and areas of expertise.

## CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

### 24 Business Management (2 or 3 Quarters)

Designed for students who have four or more years of full-time professional-level work experience or students who have a university degree with one year of full-time professional work experience.

#### Program overview:

The Business Management program offers the opportunity to build job skills and knowledge or to prepare for graduate studies through an extensive introduction to U.S. business practices. In the second quarter, you choose to specialize in one of the following areas: Finance, Marketing, or Leadership. To complement your classroom experience, Business Management incorporates a 120-hour internship into the program.

#### Program Benefits:

- Develop solid business management skills through courses led by practicing industry professionals.
- Learn resume writing and interviewing skills; receive a professional resume critique.
- Study alongside American students in select evening classes to further enhance your network.
- Apply for Optional Practical Training (OPT), which allows students to work in the U.S. for up to one year, after three consecutive quarters of study.

#### Business Management Overview

##### 1st Quarter

Required courses:

- Elements of Marketing
- Financial Accounting for Non-Accountants (FAFNA)
- Organizational Behavior
- Internship Preparation

##### 2nd Quarter

Required courses and internship experience:

- Business Decision-Making
- 120 hours of internship

Three required courses in area of specialization:

- Finance
- Leadership
- Marketing

#### 3rd Quarter

##### Advanced Studies:

Students who successfully complete two quarters of Business Management can further develop their skills in an area of specialization and earn a Certificate of Completion in Advanced Studies.

#### Courses include:

- Capstone project or class
- One required course in area of specialization
- Electives: Students will have the opportunity to choose 2–3 additional classes.

### 25 Project Management Certificate Program (2 Quarters)

Designed for students who have a university degree and one year of full-time professional work experience or four or more years of full-time professional-level work experience.

#### Program overview:

Learn the nuances of project management and process improvement from a global perspective. Students will acquire the skills to plan, execute and complete complex projects within various types of organizations and industries. The student will apply newly learned tools and methodologies in simulated hands-on projects.

#### Program Benefits:

- The curriculum fulfills the necessary Project Management Institute (PMI) education hours to prepare for the PMP or CAPM certification exam.
- Transfer select units to the online Master of Science in Project Management program at the University of Wisconsin, Platteville, upon certificate completion.

Tuition \$12,000 USD

### LEAN SIX SIGMA GREEN BELT CERTIFICATE

Students may participate in Lean Six Sigma Green Belt to improve quality and streamline process activities while they complete the Project Management Certificate.

The curriculum fulfills the American Society for Quality's (ASQ) educational requirements needed to prepare for the Six Sigma Green Belt Certification (CSSBB) exam.

Tuition \$3,000 USD

### 26 Paralegal Certificate (1 Quarter)

Designed for students who have a university degree and have a professional background in law or an equivalent profession.

#### Program overview:

Approved by the American Bar Association (ABA), the Paralegal Certificate combines practical skills with legal theory and analysis. Participants focus on civil litigation, legal research, writing, interviewing, and substantive and procedural law.

To provide students a balanced perspective and expertise in the legal field, classes are taught by prominent attorneys, judges, and advanced paralegals.

#### Program Benefits:

- Students have the opportunity to become a certificated paralegal in just three months
- Hands-on practical assignments led by legal professional experts
- Designed to give students access to legal organizations and networking events in the legal community
- Offers students the ability to build their skills in criminal and civil law, intellectual property, and various areas of law

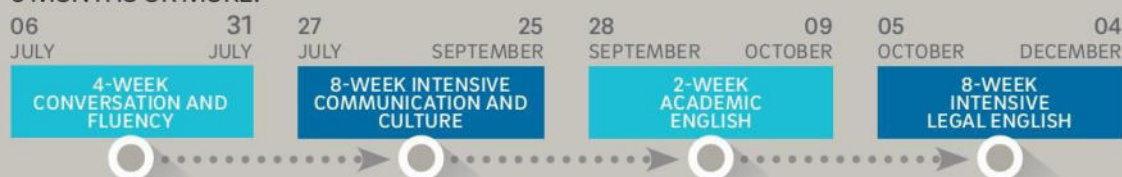
