Business Management (2 or 3 Quarters)

Designed for students who have four or more years of full-time professional-level work experience or students who have a university degree with one year of full-time professional work experience.

Program overview:

The Business Management program offers the opportunity to build job skills and knowledge or to prepare for graduate studies through an extensive introduction to U.S. business practices. In the second quarter, you choose to specialize in one of the following areas: Finance, Marketing, or Leadership. To complement your classroom experience, Business Management incorporates a 120-hour internship into the program.


