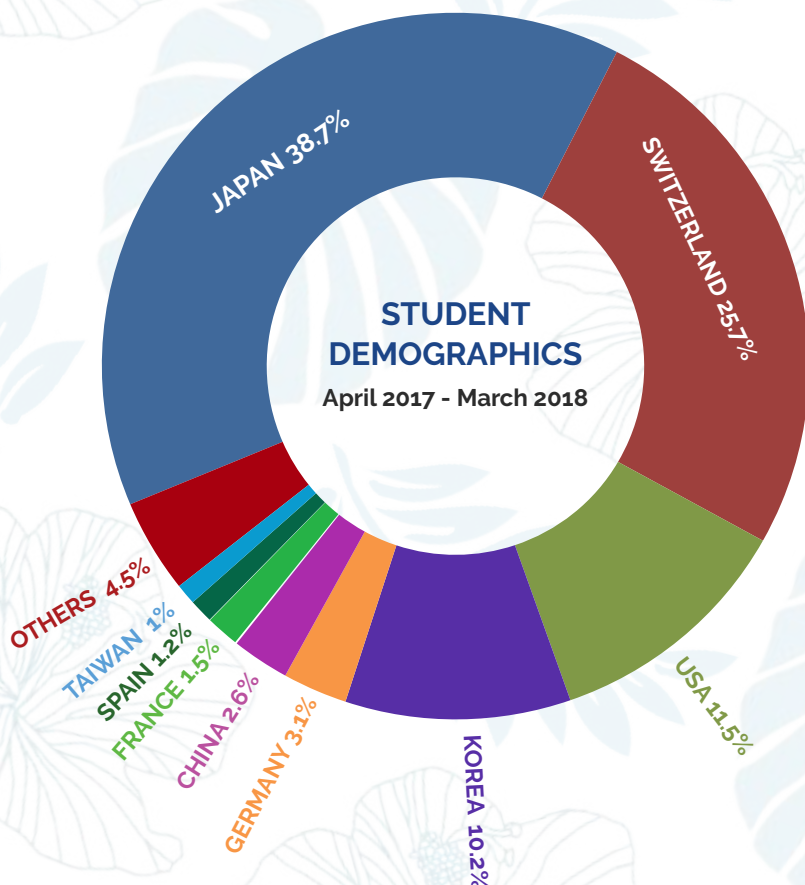

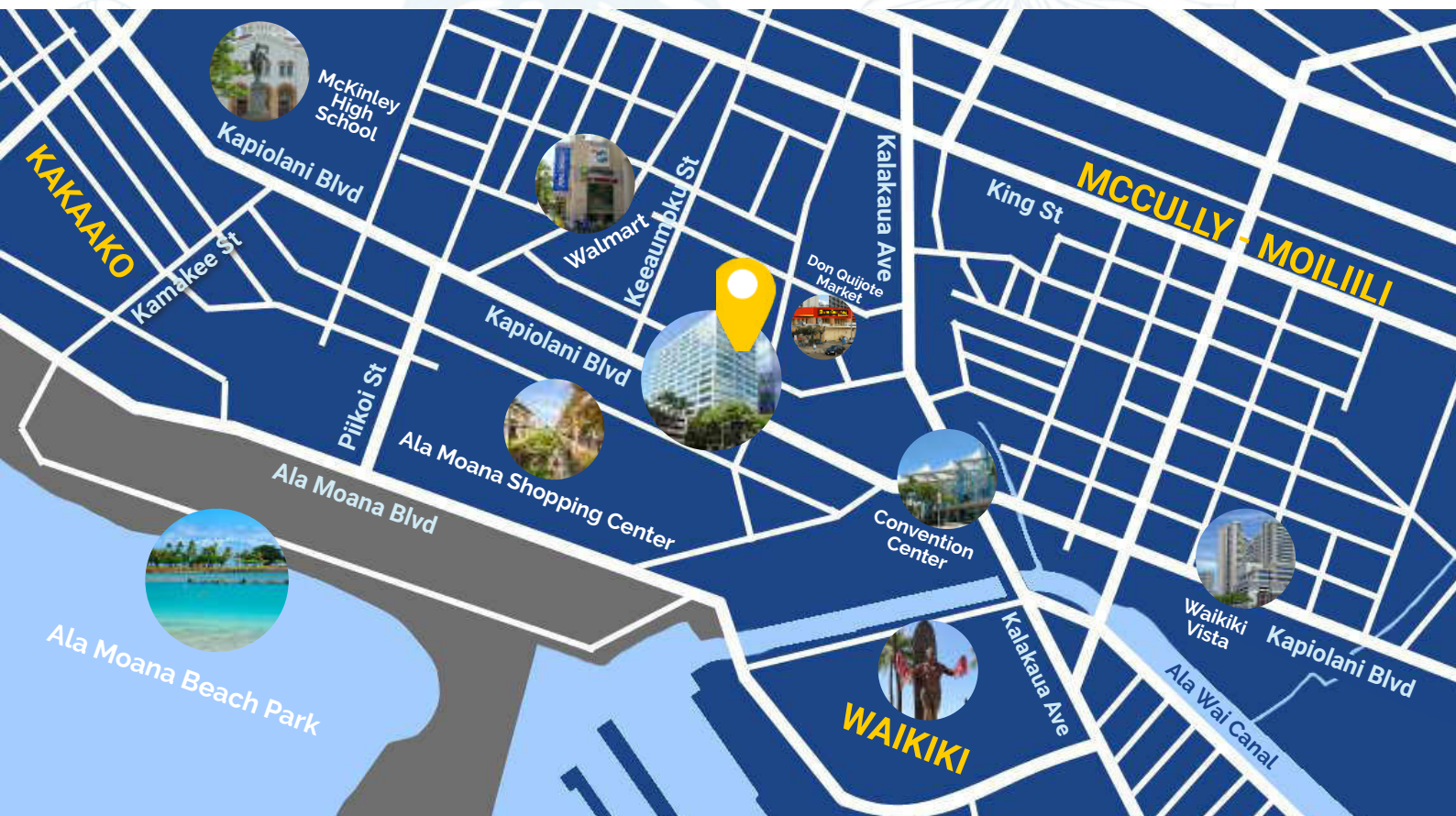
STUDY WITH STUDENTS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

CLASS COMPARISON
