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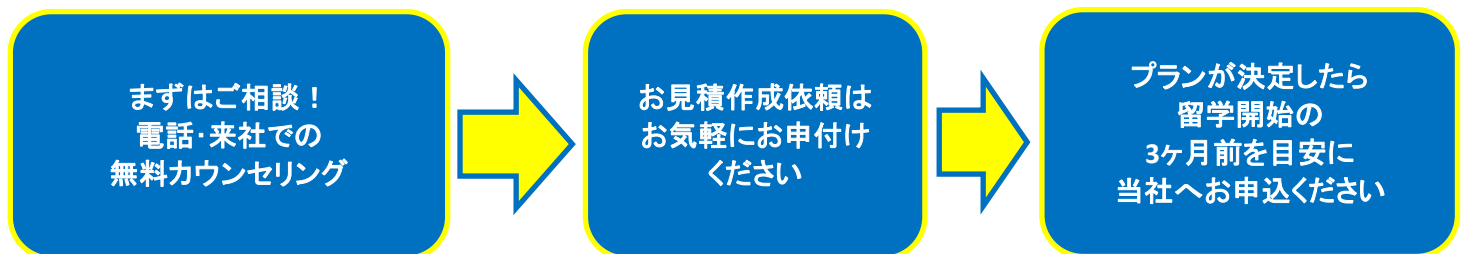

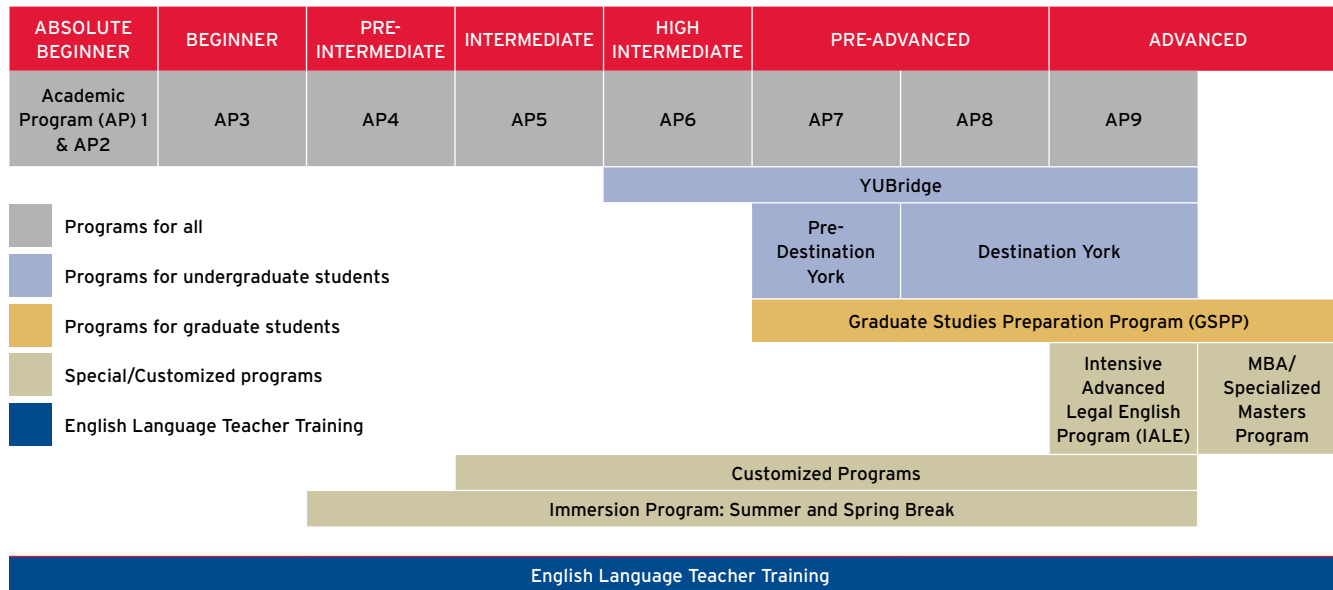

Students also participate in activities, trips, and social events organized by York University Community Leaders, giving you the opportunity to build your skills and confidence in preparation for your future university life.

An alternative to IELTS and TOEFL

The Academic Program was designed as a comprehensive English for Academic Purposes (EAP) preparation for students at any level of English. This helps students learn English to the level they need – from basic communication skills to completing a PhD. Our unique program allows students from AP6 to AP9 to sit in on many courses at York University and experience what it's like first-hand. From these levels, students can apply for conditional admission to York University.

- Students from over 70 nationalities have enrolled in this program over the last 5 years!
- York University students hold Conversation Partner sessions every week and host regular social and interactive clubs and activities.
- Students who complete any Level between AP6 to AP9 of the Academic Program (with Honours or Distinction if necessary) will meet the language requirements for entry to York University.

Learn while you make friends and have fun

AP gives you the chance to participate in social activities and trips, practice your English outside the classroom and build your confidence! In addition, AP3-AP9 students choose a seminar each session to complement their core class objectives.

YUBridge

Get started on your degree while you improve your English to meet the York University entry requirements!

Program Overview

Students accepted into the YUBridge program receive a conditional offer of acceptance to York University. This program combines 25 hours per week of instruction, which includes Academic English classes, tutorials and lectures with for-credit courses in faculties of Liberal Arts & Professional Studies, Science, Health, Environmental Studies, Lassonde School of Engineering, and School of Arts, Media, Performance and Design. In 4 to 8 months, you'll be speaking and writing at an IELTS 6.5 level – the minimum requirement for full admission to York University.

Earn credits as you learn English

While improving your IELTS level, you will also take one 3-credit course in the first term. Upon successful completion of the language requirements in Term 1, you may be eligible to enrol in one or two 3-credit courses in Term 2, meaning that you could earn 9 credits of your undergraduate degree by the end of this program. Students who are enrolled in the 4 month option only are eligible for one 3-credit course.

Once you start in the YUBridge program, you are considered an undergraduate student at York. You will take the same courses as fully admitted York students, helping to build relationships with the students and staff in your Faculty.

Your tutorial leaders are chosen specifically for their experience working with international students, and academic tutorials are taught separately, so class sizes remain small. This structure also enables the English language course content to be tailored to the undergraduate area you're studying, making YUBridge classroom activities highly relevant to your future studies.

Destination York is an 8-week pathway program that you can enrol in after applying to a degree program at York. Successful completion of Destination York fulfills the York U language entry requirement, with no test required (no IELTS or TOEFL). The program is taught by qualified instructors and features an innovative curriculum. Students enrolled in the program will have access to York University support services.

In Destination York, you continue to learn, both within and outside of classroom hours. These opportunities are offered in the form of seminars, workshops, volunteering, clubs, trips and interactive events.

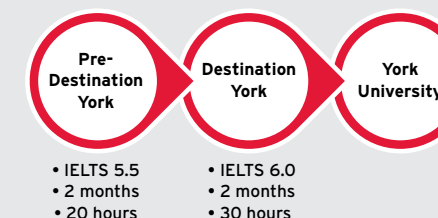

The Graduate Studies Preparation Program (GSPP) is designed for international students who want to attend graduate studies programs in English. GSPP coursework focuses on the English language, academic, and professional skills and strategies needed in day-to-day graduate school assignments/tasks/experiences and to communicate effectively with professors, graduate students, and graduate program administrators. At the same time, it is designed to prepare program participants to achieve the test scores (IELTS, GRE/GMAT) necessary for graduate program admission and offer comprehensive professional advisory sessions about Master's applications/pathways.

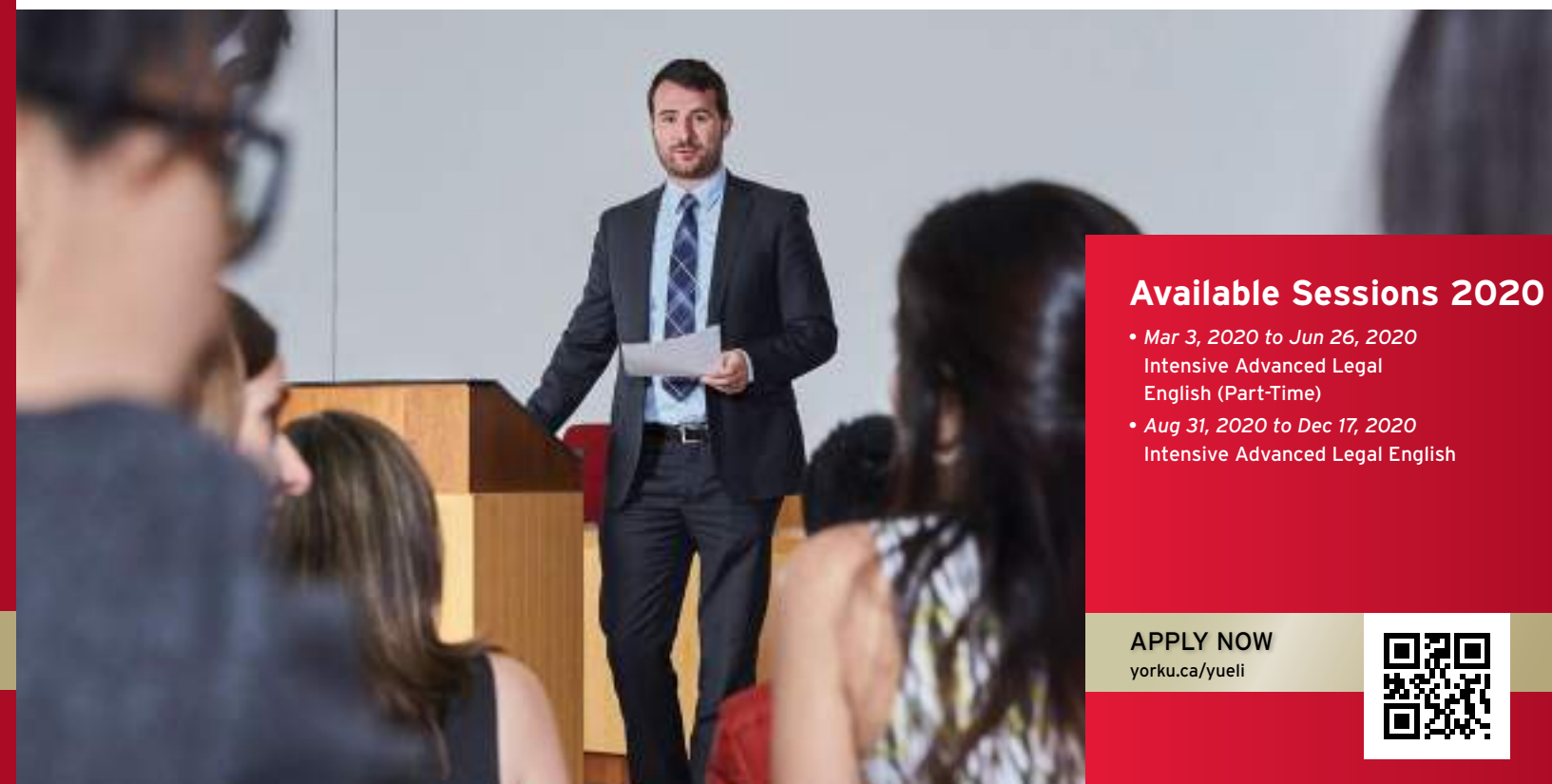

MBA/Specialized Masters Preparation Program

Get ready for your MBA or Master's studies in just 8 weeks

The MBA/Specialized Masters Preparation Program will help you prepare for graduate studies in business at Schulich School of Business or other graduate business programs by advancing your English language proficiency in reading, writing, listening, and speaking skill areas, targeting graduate-level academic and real-world business contexts.

Develop the skills needed to be effective in a North American MBA or graduate-level business study program.

The MBA/Specialized Masters Preparation Program is a full-time English course for students with suitable English-language proficiency (see the requirements below) who wish to further improve their language skills to meet graduate-level business study standards.

As a graduate of this program, you will be equipped with the English language skills needed to apply to the MBA program or another master's-level program at York University's Schulich School of Business (Canada's top business school) or to a graduate-level business program at another top-tier university.

Intensive language study is delivered through business-related projects, field trips, and guest speakers from the Canadian business world, ensuring a learning experience with a real-world edge.

You will gain confidence as you work independently and in teams to conduct research, review case studies, analyze economic and financial data, draft a written report, participate in networking and interview situations, and deliver a presentation to evaluators from York University's Schulich School of Business.

Pre-MFin

Over 3 weeks in July, the Pre-MFin focuses intensively on developing your English language and academic business culture skills. The program content is based on authentic material from the world of finance.

Each Pre-MFin class integrates reading, writing, critical analysis skills and presentation skills. It also provides plenty of opportunities to improve communications skills that are key to academic and career success.

- 6 hours/day - 4 morning hours, 2 afternoon hours
- Mainly supports 1-year Master's of Finance students

In the second part of the Pre-MFin Program starting in September, you will begin the BMAP.

Together, the Pre-MFin/BMAP package strives to enhance your skills and prepare you for success. The program also builds your confidence to exceed expectations in your Master's studies and life-long career goals.

- **Classroom hours/week:** 3 hours
- September to February
- An adjunct program - for PreMFin students when they start the Master's of Finance program at Schulich

Admission Requirements for both Business (PreMBA) and Finance (Pre-MFin) program streams

- **Previous education:** An undergraduate degree and have met ONE of the following English-language proficiency requirements below.
- **Language proficiency:**
 - IELTS: minimum score 6.5 overall with no more than one component at 6.0
 - TOEFL: minimum score 560 (paper), 220 (computer), or 87 (iBT)
- AP9 completion with honours or distinction
- YUELI Graduate Studies Preparation Program (GSPP): successful completion of GSPP Term 1 with a recommendation to the MBA/Specialized Master's Preparation Program from GSPP instructors

English Language Teacher Training Programs

Since 2002, YUELI has built considerable experience in the design and implementation of English language teacher training programs. Training programs can be delivered on campus at York University or on-site/on location at the partner's premises, in a blended learning format or completely online. These programs help to develop the specialized language needed by non-native English-speaking professors and teachers to conduct their classes in English, as well as develop strategies for effective oral and written communication.

Beginning in January 2017, YUELI began hosting 59 participants in the Building Leadership for Change through School Immersion offered by the Ministry of Education in Saudi Arabia. The goal of this six-month program is to transform knowledge, skills, and attitudes of Saudi education professionals through university-guided immersion in Canadian schools. To achieve this goal, YUELI is collaborating with York's Faculty of Education and the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) to deliver proficiency-appropriate language training at YUELI, individualized guidance through the Faculty of Education, and school immersion at leading TDSB schools.

Since 2016, YUELI has welcomed participants into the Bachelor of Education English Immersion Programme comprised of senior BEd English students from the Education University of Hong Kong. EduHK is a valued partner. It has a QS ranking in Education of #2 in Asia and #12 globally. Through this immersion programme, students significantly improved their English language proficiency. They also enhanced their understanding of Canadian culture and education through their exposure to ESL expertise and practices at a premier language institute. Concurrent with their studies, students completed a two-week TDSB classroom practicum, including observations and practice teaching.

YUELI has also designed teacher training programs for provincial ministries and universities from Jiangsu and Sichuan Provinces, China, and for groups of teachers from Mongolia. Those who completed the programs praised them for their unique three-part approach to training, which included classes and seminars on Teaching Methodologies, as well as on Language Form and Function and Comparative Culture and Language. In these, and all YUELI Teacher Training Programs, participants have opportunities to assess and compare teaching methodologies used in Canada, to design lesson plans together with YUELI instructors, to observe instructors' approaches to teaching, and to teach ESL classes at YUELI using the new methods they have learned.

In addition to Toronto-based teacher training, YUELI instructors travel abroad to run similar programs. Two such programs, in Palestine and in Turkey, were launched in the past four years. The program in Turkey was notable for the scale of the training. YUELI was responsible for overhauling the English preparatory curriculum for 400 students at Istanbul Commerce University (ICU) and for training 25 ICU instructors on how to use the new curriculum.
