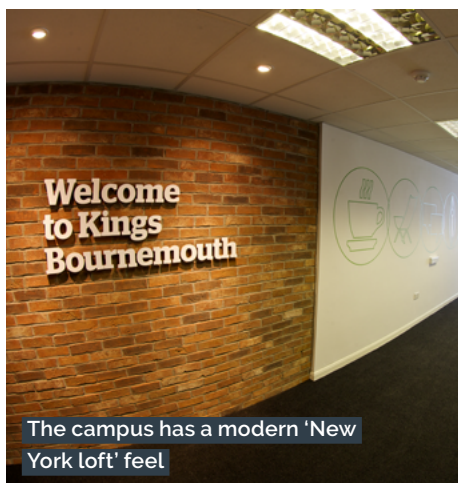

This spectacular building was originally built as a Royal Palace. It features an exotic design and eclectic contents from all over the world.



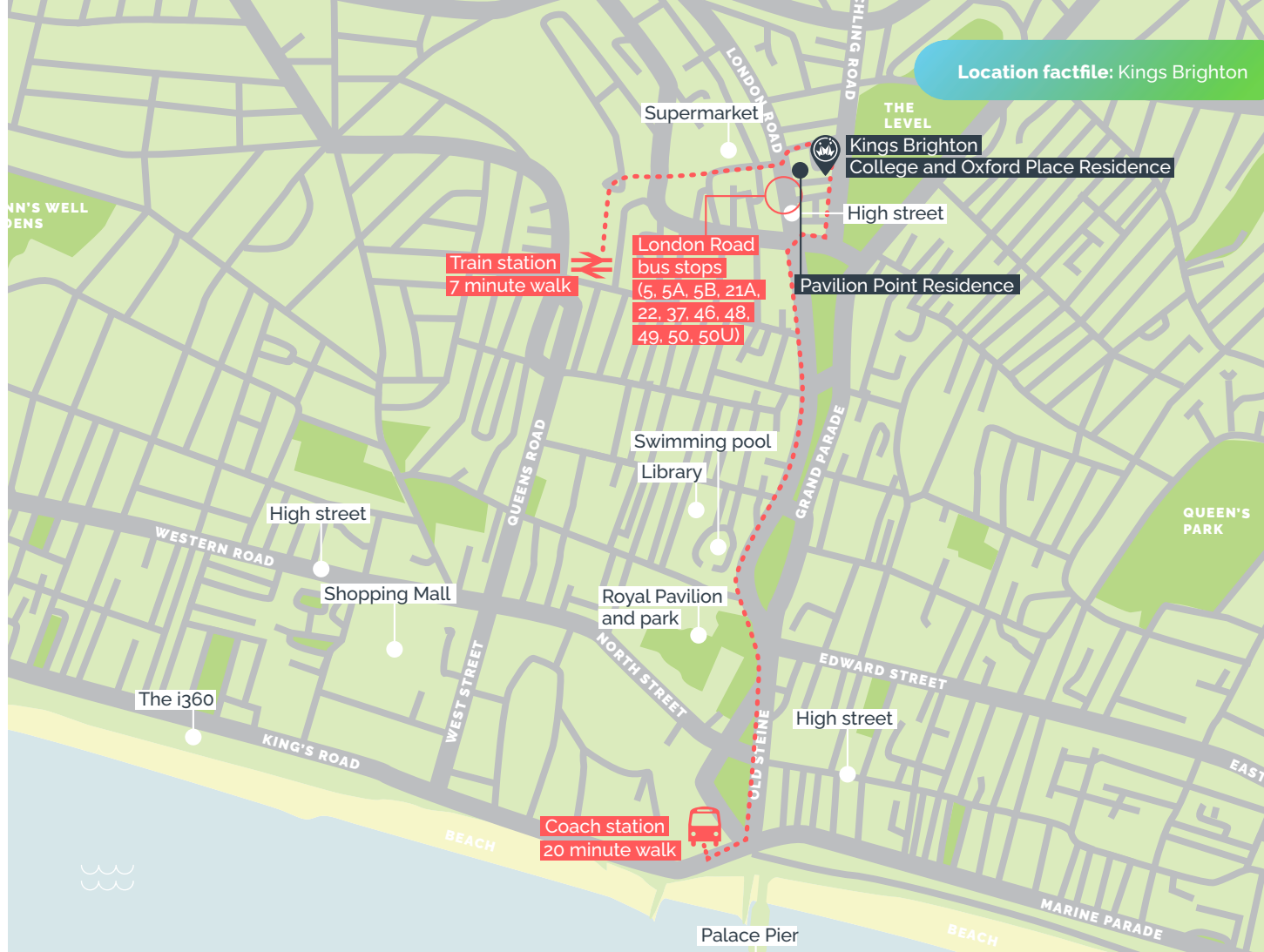
**The North Laine and South Lanes**

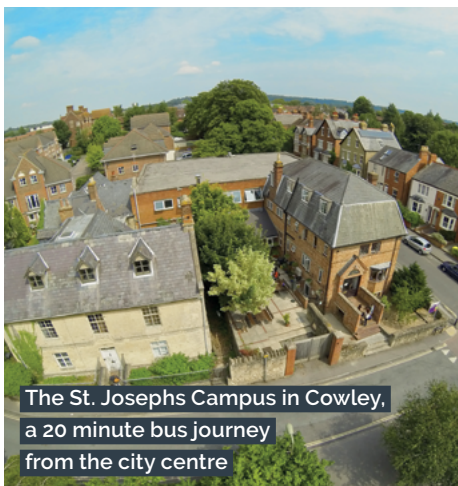
